Early Learning Connections is a private, non-profit school providing a variety of children's programs since 1973. Previously Butler County Children's Center, the agency now serves children and families in five counties—Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Indiana and Lawrence.



THE PROBLEM

Early Learning Connections found themselves without a designated employee fully dedicated to IT. Although one individual had some experience with IT, it's a full-time job that's difficult to do on top of other responsibilities. With the quick expansion from one county to five, and the employee previously handling IT moving on to a new opportunity, ELC needed a helping hand to take ownership of their networks.

WHY MIDNIGHTBLUE?

Nancy Feth, Director of Human Resources, had worked with MidnightBlue at a previous employer. When ELC found themselves in a similar position, she knew just who to call.
